

## **Registration of optional courses for the academic year 2022/2023**

**the FIRST round of registration is opened**

**from 4<sup>th</sup> April by 10<sup>th</sup> April 2022**

**Registration should be done electronically via UIS <http://is.czu.cz/>**

Every student of a **bachelor** study program:

- **Environmental Engineering** – The student must take one optional core course, Type 1, during the 3<sup>rd</sup> year of the study, and the student must take one optional core course, Type 2, during the 3<sup>rd</sup> year of the study.
- **Geographic Information Systems and Remote Sensing in Environmental Sciences** - The student must take at least two core optional courses, Type A, during the second and third years of the study. For those taking final exams in Ecology and Nature Conservation, a combination of Habitat Ecology and Nature Conservation is recommended. For those taking final exams in Hydrology and Water Management, the combination of Water Management and Climate Change and Water Resources should be the preferred one. The student must choose from those courses in the second and third years of study in a way ensuring that he/she earns in total (combining these with compulsory courses and core optional courses) 180 credits over the entire study period. In other words, the student must earn at least 35 credits during his/her studies combining core optional (Type A) and optional courses (Type B)
- **Environmental Data Science** – The student must take minimum 15 ECTS from optional course from the winter semester of all specialization and minimum 10 ECTS from optional course from the summer semester of all specialization. Your specialization has priority in the choice of your ECTS.

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Every student of a **Master's degree (Environmental Geosciences)** study program proceeding to the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of study has to choose the courses from the actual offer of the optional courses for the academic year 2022/2023. The minimum credit limit is set by the study plan of the relevant study program. The list of the optional courses that are currently offered is available on the FES website – Study – Information for students and on Study Administration Office notice boards.

**The SECOND round of the registration is opened**

**from 18<sup>th</sup> April by 24<sup>th</sup> April 2022**

During the 2<sup>nd</sup> round, a student has to check the chosen courses – if they are opened or not. If the chosen course is not opened, the student has to replenish his list of optional courses (with the opened ones) during the period of the second round.

**A notice to students:**

The courses have to be opted in the set periods (rounds) with your careful consideration. Additional cancellation of the optional courses (via written request in Contact Center) out of the periods of the first and second rounds is possible only during the first two weeks of the winter semester 2022/2023 academic year.

The timetable of the optional courses can coincide with the courses that are already scheduled.
