Who are we?

ESQESE school has been training Quality, Health, Safety and Environment (QHSE) technicians and managers since 1994.

We are part of UCLy, the Catholic University of Lyon based in Lyon, France on a modern campus in the city centre.

All our Year 2 "QHSE coordinator" students will take part in the Green Nudge project.

Other ESQESE courses include a Masters in QHSE management and a bachelors in computer science.





Theme « The Green Nudge »

How can we help Lyon's citizens to make little choices each day that improve the environmental impact of the city?

Over an intensive week of activities at ESQESE, Lyon you will:

- Learn « Nudge » techniques, developed thanks to recent advances in behaviour science.
- **Explore Lyon** and identify problems that need your creativity
- Create designs and communication ideas that tackle the environmental challenges of the city

What is a "Nudge"

Everyday we take hundreds of little decisions on-the-spot: Should I walk or take my car to the shops today? Do I throw this cigarette butt on the ground or in the bin?

A Nudge is a non-intrusive design or communication technique to quide people to make environmentallyfriendly choices at these moments.

Pedagogy

Our project is designed to maximize student participation, interaction in English, and creativity:

- Hackathon in multinational mixed teams (Germany, Czechia, France...)
- Workshops and games to learn about environmental topics and explore Lyon
- Compete in teams to find the best solutions to convince the jury and win awards at the end of the week.
- On-line support for English and team collaboration, before and after the week.

What is a "Hackathon"?

An intensive competetive team-work process to encourage creative solutions to a problem

Your university can apply for Erasmus funding « Short Blended Mobility » that is granted to students to cover the costs of transport to France and accommodation.

Students completing this module are accredited 3 European credits (ECTS)
