

## Enrolment in higher years of study for the 2024/2025 academic year

## **WILL TAKE PLACE THROUGH THE CONTACT CENTRE**

Enrolment in higher years for full and part-time students for the 2024/2025 academic year will take place on the following dates:

## 9 - 13 September 2024

- Students who have <u>attained 50 credits or more</u> and have completed all assessments and exams, and students who are transferring a maximum of 2 incomplete courses, select the <u>Request to enrol to the subsequent study year (I have obtained at least 50 ECTS)</u> form in the Contact Centre and attach their study overview (found in the student portal Print documents Study overview).
- Students who have <u>attained at least 25 credits up to and including 49 credits</u> can advance to a higher year of study based on the decision of the faculty management and therefore select the Request to enrol in the subsequent study year (I have obtained a minimum of 25 and a maximum 49 ECTS) form in the Contact Centre, list which courses they have not fulfilled and attach their study overview (found in the Student portal Print documents Study overview).
  - 3. Students who will be <u>repeating a year</u> will select the <u>Request to repeat Study year/Study Programme</u> form in the Contact Centre, list the uncompleted courses and attach their Study overview (found in the student portal Print documents Study overview). If they also need to apply for an exception from the Dean of the Faculty due to enrolling in a course for a third time or repeating a repeat year, they should note that on this form!
- Students who decide not to continue their studies will select the Announcement of Study termination/Leave form from the Contact Centre.

We would like to inform you that the last date for taking assessments and exams is 6 September 2024. Before enrolling each student will check that all assessments and exams have been completed in UIS. The 2024/2025 academic year will begin on 30 September 2024.
