

Registration for Optional Courses for the Academic Year 2024/2025

The FIRST round of registration is opened

from 8th April till 14th April 2024

Registration should be done electronically via the UIS <http://is.czu.cz/>

Every student of a **Bachelor study programme** is to obey the following instructions:

- **Environmental Engineering** – a student must take one optional core course Type 1, and also one optional core course Type 2 during the 3rd year of study.
- **Environmental Data Science** – a student must obtain at least 15 ECTS from optional winter semester courses that are offered within their programme specialization, and at least 10 ECTS from optional summer semester courses offered within the programme specialization. Your specialization has priority in the choice of your ECTS.

Every student of a **Master (Environmental Geosciences) study programme** proceeding to the 2nd year of study has to choose the courses from the current offer of the optional courses for the academic year 2024/2025. The minimum credit limit is set by the study plan of the particular study programme. The list of the optional courses that are currently offered is available on the FZP website (Study – Information for students).

The SECOND round of registration is opened


from 22nd April till 28th April 2024

During the 2nd round, a student has to check if the chosen courses are opened or not. If the chosen course is not opened, the student has to choose another course instead during the second round of course registration.

An important notice to students:

The courses have to be chosen within the given periods (rounds) upon careful consideration. The course the student has registered for becomes binding. Cancellation of the chosen optional courses outside the periods of the first and second rounds is possible only during the first two weeks of the winter semester of the academic year 2024/2025 (by means of a written request in the UIS Contact Centre – General Request). The timetable of the optional courses can coincide with other courses that are already scheduled. The open optional course may be cancelled for serious personnel reasons; if so, students will be informed via student's email.
