Dean's Regulation no. 7/2025

Establishing the Obligation to Complete Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) and Fire Protection (FP) Training for FES Students at the Czech University of Life Sciences Prague

1. Introductory Provisions

Occupational Health and Safety and Fire Protection (hereinafter referred to as "OHS" and "FP") include a set of rules, measures, and procedures aimed at ensuring safe working conditions, minimizing the risk of injury, and protecting the health of employees and students at the relevant workplaces of the Faculty of Environmental Sciences (hereinafter referred to as "the faculty" or "FES") of the Czech University of Life Sciences Prague (hereinafter referred to as "CZU"). This regulation is issued in accordance with, in particular:

- Act No. 262/2006 Coll., the Labour Code, as amended,
- Act No. 309/2006 Coll., stipulating further requirements for occupational health and safety in employment relationships and ensuring safety and health protection during activities or service provision outside employment relationships (Act on Further Requirements for OHS), as amended,
- Act No. 111/1998 Coll., on Higher Education Institutions and on Amendments and Supplements to Some Other Acts (the Higher Education Act), as amended,
- Internal CZU regulations relating to OHS and FP.

The responsibilities and duties of the faculty and its students concerning OHS and FP are fully governed by the above legal regulations and CZU internal policies.

This Dean's Regulation is binding for all bachelor's, master's, and doctoral students participating in any form of study at the faculty, as well as for all faculty students participating in internships or exchange programs at other institutions, regardless of the length of stay. It is also binding for students of lifelong learning programs.

2. Organization of OHS and FP Training

The OHS and FP training is organized through five courses in the LMS Moodle platform, designated for the following groups of faculty students:

- 1. Students of bachelor's and master's degree programs taught in Czech.
- 2. Students of bachelor's and master's degree programs taught in English.
- 3. Students of doctoral degree programs taught in Czech.
- 4. Students of doctoral degree programs taught in English.
- 5. Students participating in study stays and internships.

The OHS and FP training is carried out in two stages. The first stage involves familiarizing oneself with the rules, measures, and procedures in the field of OHS and FP through self-study. The second stage consists of verifying the acquired knowledge via a final e-test, which is available during designated periods.

After logging into their student account in LMS Moodle, FES students have access to study materials related to OHS and FP as well as to the final e-test. To successfully complete the OHS and FP training, the student must correctly answer at least 10 out of 15 questions in the final e-test within the specified deadline.

Basic information about the obligation to complete OHS training – including a link to the relevant LMS Moodle page, deadlines, and any penalties for non-compliance – will be sent to students' university email addresses well in advance.

Additional necessary OHS training is provided according to the specific requirements of the relevant workplace.

3. Sanctions for Non-Compliance

If a student fails to fulfill the obligation to complete the OHS training by the deadline set by this Dean's Regulation, disciplinary proceedings may be initiated, which could result in termination of the student's studies at the faculty. The deadlines for fulfilling the OHS training obligation are as follows:

- Students of bachelor's, master's, and doctoral programs taught in Czech and English, enrolled before the start of classes in the academic year – the obligation must be fulfilled no later than one week before the start of classes in the winter semester.
- Students of bachelor's and master's programs taught in English, and students on study stays and internships enrolled after the start of classes – the obligation must be fulfilled no later than one week after enrollment.
