

Dean's Regulation no. 7/2026

The fees for study undertaken in the English language for the academic year 2026/2027

In accordance with Section 58, paragraph 4 of Act No. 111/1998 Coll., on Higher Education Institutions and on Amendments and Supplements to Other Acts (Act on the Higher Education Institutions), as amended, and in accordance with the internal regulations of the Czech University of Life Sciences Prague (hereinafter referred to as "CZU"), the Dean of the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU determines the amount of the tuition fees for studying in a foreign language at the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU (hereinafter referred to as "tuition fees") for the academic year 2026/2027 as follows:

* The costs of study for some students are financed by the project Knowledge Alliances ECOLUTION 621568-EPP-1-2020-1-PT-EPPKA2-KA, see Dean's Regulation No. 8/2025. The selection of funded students is part of the admission procedure.

Tuition fees under this regulation apply to students who commence study in study programmes taught in English in the academic year 2026/2027 and will be valid for the standard duration of their studies.

Students who commenced their studies in study programmes taught in English before this academic year are subject to the fees set by the previous internal regulation, effective on their enrollment date. If the fees were reduced during the standard study period, the lowest fees apply to these students.

The tuition fee is paid according to the instructions set by the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU and is considered paid on the day the tuition fee is credited to the bank account of the CZU or deposited at the cash desk of the CZU. This tuition fee is non-refundable after enrollment. In case of a refund of the paid tuition fee (before enrollment), the applicant will be refunded the amount minus EUR 50. This amount is used to cover the administrative costs associated with processing the payment and refund. The refund amount may also differ from the original tuition fee due to changes in the exchange rate and bank charges related to international transfers.
