



Dean's Regulation No. 9/2026

Conditions of the admission procedure for bachelor's and master's degree programmes taught in English in full-time and combined forms of study for the academic year 2027/2028 at the Faculty of Environmental Sciences of the Czech University of Life Sciences Prague

Part A

Conditions of the admission procedure for bachelor's degree programmes taught in English in full-time form of study for the academic year 2027/2028 at the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU

1. Announcement of the conditions of the admission procedure

In accordance with Sections 48 to 50 of Act No. 111/1998 Coll., on Higher Education Institutions and on Amendments and Supplements to Other Acts (Act on the Higher Education Institutions), as amended (hereinafter referred to as the "ACT"), and in accordance with the internal regulations of the Czech University of Life Sciences Prague (hereinafter referred to as "CZU"), the Dean of the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU announces the conditions of the admission procedure for admission to bachelor's degree programmes taught in English in full-time form of study for the academic year 2027/2028 at the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU (hereinafter referred to as the "Admission Procedure").

The essential condition for admission to a bachelor's degree programme is, pursuant to Section 48 of the AHEI, successful completion of secondary education and successful completion of the General Academic Prerequisites test (GAP test). In accordance with Section 49 and Section 58(1) and (4) of the AHEI, the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU sets the following additional conditions:

- The Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU accepts applications only in the form of an electronic form. The electronic form is available at <https://is.czu.cz/prihlaska/>.
- An application to the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU can be submitted only after payment of the registration fee (see the details below). The "application registration number", which the applicant receives at their e-mail address after creating the application, serves as the specific symbol of the payment.

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The fee can be paid by transfer to the account number stated above or online by payment card via the payment gateway in the electronic application. The fee is payable by the latest date for submitting the application of the relevant stage of the admission procedure. The fee is non-refundable at any stage of the admission procedure.

If the payment sent for a submitted application does not appear as paid within 10 working days, the applicant contacts the officer of the International Relations Office of the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU (admission_fes@fzp.czu.cz).

2. Organisation of the admission procedure

This regulation announces the first and second phases of the admission procedure. If the maximum capacity of the number of admitted applicants in the individual bachelor's degree programmes is not filled (see Annex 1), the Dean of the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU may decide to open a further phase of the Admission Procedure for selected bachelor's degree programmes.

2.1 Schedule of the admission procedure

First phase

Deadline for submitting applications together with the required documents and payment of the application fee	15 September 2026 – 15 January 2027
Meeting of the main admission committee and announcement of the results of the first phase of the admission procedure	by 28 February 2027

Second phase

Deadline for submitting applications together with the required documents and payment of the application fee	1 February 2027 – 31 March 2027
Meeting of the main admission committee and announcement of the results of the second phase of the admission procedure	by 25 May 2027

2.2 Documents to be submitted

The applicant submits the following documents to the Admission Procedure:

- secondary school diploma / school-leaving certificate; an applicant who completes secondary school only after the deadline for submitting applications, but no later than by the end of September 2027, submits a confirmation of secondary school study with the expected date of completion of study.
- the result of a GAP test taken within the 2 years preceding the commencement of this Admission Procedure (the applicant does not submit the result of a GAP test taken during the Admission Procedure themselves; see point 2.3 for details)



These documents are part of the application and are uploaded via <http://is.czu.cz/prihlaska> (hereinafter referred to as the “e-application”) before submitting the application.

2.3 General Academic Prerequisites test (GAP test)

The GAP test is provided by the company SCIO (<https://www.scioexams.com/general-academic-prerequisites>). The GAP test is subject to a fee according to the current price list, which applicants pay to SCIO. After registering for the GAP test, applicants will be contacted by representatives of SCIO in order to specify the conditions of participation in the GAP test. After evaluating the GAP test, SCIO passes the GAP test results to the applicants and to the International Relations Office of the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU. Applicants do not themselves submit the results of the GAP test that they take within the current admission procedure at the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU.

If an applicant has already successfully completed a GAP test within the 2 years preceding the Admission Procedure and wishes to apply the test result within this Admission Procedure, they upload the official result of the previous GAP test as one of the documents to the e-application. The result of this GAP test will be taken into account in the admission procedure. If the applicant also registers for the GAP test in the relevant stage of this admission procedure, the better of the GAP test results will be taken into account.

3. Evaluation of the admission procedure

Only applications meeting the formal requirements (without obvious defects, complete and paid) and submitted within the deadline according to the schedule of the relevant stage of the admission procedure (see point 2.1) are evaluated.

The result of the admission procedure will be based on the score awarded for the GAP test [0-100 points]. On the basis of the GAP test results, the admission committee sets the points threshold for successfully passing the entrance examination.

The maximum numbers of applicants admitted to the individual bachelor's degree programmes are stated in Annex 1.

- The proposal for admission to study based on the GAP test results is determined by the main admission committee. The results of the admission procedure will be made available to applicants via the web portal <https://is.czu.cz/prihlaska/>.

4. After admission

4.1 Decision on admission

The proposal for admission to study is made by the main admission committee based on the fulfilment of all formal conditions and the result of the entrance examination. Applicants who are admitted to study will be asked to pay the tuition fee and to submit the following documents on the education attained:

Applicants who are graduates of a foreign secondary school submit



- a document on completion of secondary education in the Czech or English language that meets the conditions specified in Section 48(4) of the AHEI.

Applicants who are graduates of Czech secondary schools submit

- a document on completion of secondary education in the Czech language that meets the conditions specified in Section 48(1) of the AHEI.

After verification of the above conditions and payment of the tuition fee, the decision on admission will be sent to applicants to the contact address stated in the application, or they will be invited to collect the decision on admission in person.

4.2 Tuition fee

The tuition fee in the current academic year is set by separate Regulation No. 10/2026. After enrolment in study, the tuition fee is non-refundable.

Tuition fees under this regulation apply to students who commence study in study programmes taught in English in the academic year 2027/2028 and will be valid for the standard duration of their studies.

4.3 Enrolment in study

Details on the enrolment process and the required documents will be sent to admitted applicants via the web portal <https://is.czu.cz/prihlaska/>. The schedule of enrolment of admitted applicants in study is regulated by Annex 2.



Part B

Conditions of the admission procedure for master's degree programmes taught in English in full-time and combined form of study for the academic year 2027/2028 at the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU

1. Announcement of the conditions of the admission procedure

In accordance with Sections 48 to 50 of Act No. 111/1998 Coll., on Higher Education Institutions and on Amendments and Supplements to Other Acts (Act on the Higher Education Institutions), as amended (hereinafter referred to as the "Act", and in accordance with the internal regulations of the Czech University of Life Sciences Prague (hereinafter referred to as "CZU"), the Dean of the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU announces the conditions of the admission procedure for admission to master's degree programmes taught in English in full-time and combined form of study for the academic year 2027/2028 at the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU (hereinafter referred to as the "Admission Procedure").

The essential condition for admission to a master's degree programme is, pursuant to Section 48 of the AHEI, successful completion of study in any type of higher education degree programme. In accordance with Section 49 and Section 58(1) and (4) of the AHEI, the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU sets the following additional conditions:

- The Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU accepts applications only via an electronic form. The electronic form is available at <https://is.czu.cz/prihlaska/>.
- An application to the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU can be submitted only after payment of the registration fee (see the details below). The "application registration number", which the applicant receives at their e-mail address after creating the application, serves as the specific symbol of the payment.

If the payment sent for a submitted application does not appear as paid within 10 working days, the applicant contacts the officer of the International Relations Office of the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU (admission_fes@fzp.czu.cz).



2. Organisation of the admission procedure

This regulation announces the first and second phases of the admission procedure. If the maximum capacity of the number of admitted applicants in the individual master's degree programmes is not filled (see Annex 1), the Dean of the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU may decide to open a further phase of the Admission Procedure for selected master's degree programmes. Within each stage, the admission procedure is organised in two rounds. Points obtained in the individual rounds of the admission procedure are not added together.

2.1 Schedule of the admission procedure

First phase

Submission of applications, required documents and payment of the application fee	15 September 2026 – 15 January 2027
Online test of academic prerequisites	27 January 2027
Announcement of the results of the first round of the admission procedure	by 10 February 2027
Interviews with selected applicants	11 February – 26 March 2027
Meeting of the main admission committee and announcement of the results of the first phase of the admission procedure	by 31 March 2027

Second phase

Submission of applications, required documents and payment of the application fee	1 February 2027 – 31 March 2027
Online test of academic prerequisites	13 April 2027
Announcement of the results of the first round of the admission procedure	by 23 April 2027
Interviews with selected applicants	26 April – 26 May 2027
Meeting of the main admission committee and announcement of the results of the second phase of the admission procedure	by 31 May 2027

2.2 Documents to be submitted

The applicant submits the following documents to the Admission Procedure:

- university diploma; an applicant who completes university only after the deadline for submitting applications, but no later than by the end of September 2027, submits a confirmation of study from the university;
- transcript of records from university study;
- CV in English.

These documents are part of the application and are uploaded via <http://is.czu.cz/prihlaska> before its submission.



3. Evaluation of the admission procedure

Only applications meeting the formal requirements (without obvious defects, complete and paid) and submitted within the deadline according to the schedule for the relevant stage of the Admission Procedure (see point 2.1) are evaluated. In each phase, the admission procedure is divided into two rounds.

3.1 First round – online test of academic prerequisites

In the first round of the admission procedure, the evaluation is carried out on the basis of an online test of academic prerequisites in relation to the relevant degree programme.

Information on the content and form of the test will be sent to applicants in the invitation via the web portal <https://is.czu.cz/prihlaska/>.

The result of the first round of the admission procedure will be a descending ranking of applicants based on the points awarded for the online test [0–100 points]. Based on the results of the online test of academic prerequisites, the admission committee sets the points threshold for advancing to the second round of the admission procedure.

The results of the first round of the admission procedure will be sent to applicants via the web portal <https://is.czu.cz/prihlaska/>.

3.1.1 Waiver of the first round of the admission procedure

Applicants for a master's degree programme who have completed a bachelor's degree programme at the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU or are studying in the final year of a bachelor's degree programme at the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU, it is deemed proven that they have acquired sufficient knowledge, and the first round of the Admission Procedure may be waived for them if the following conditions are met:

1. In the academic year 2026/2027, they are enrolled in the third year of bachelor's study at the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU or completed bachelor's study at the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU in 2025/2026 or 2024/2025. This fact is verified by the International Relations Office of the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU via the University Information System. Submission of the document on education is a condition for enrolment.
2. The student has submitted an application for a waiver of the online test of academic prerequisites.

In the case of a waiver of the first round of the Admission Procedure, the applicant proceeds directly to the second round of the Admission Procedure.

1. Applicants for the master's degree programme Smart Sustainable Solutions who have completed a bachelor's degree programme at the International Hellenic University of Thessaloniki (hereinafter referred to as "IHU") in the field of Industrial Engineering and Management, Environmental Engineering or Information and Electronic Engineering, or are studying in the final year of a bachelor's degree programme at IHU in the above-mentioned fields, it is deemed proven that they have



acquired sufficient knowledge and have sufficient study knowledge to proceed directly to the second round of the admission procedure., and the first round of the Admission Procedure may be waived for them if the following conditions are met: In the academic year 2026/2027, they are enrolled in the final year of bachelor's study at IHU or completed bachelor's study at IHU in the above-mentioned fields in 2025/2026 or 2024/2025. This fact is verified by the International Relations Office of the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU. Submission of the document on education is a condition for enrolment.

2. The student has submitted an application for a waiver of the online study aptitude test.

3.2 Second round – online interview

Applicants who advance to the second round of the admission procedure take an online oral interview in English. The specific date and manner of the interview will be announced to the applicant after the announcement of the results of the first round of the admission procedure via the web portal <https://is.czu.cz/prihlaska/>.

The interview itself is focused on verifying knowledge of the English language, motivation to study, study prerequisites, orientation in the chosen degree programme, and general knowledge about the Czech Republic and study at CZU. It is possible to obtain 0–30 points for the online interview. To be admitted, it is necessary to obtain at least 23 points. The result of the second round of the admission procedure will be a descending ranking of applicants based on the points awarded for the online interview. The maximum numbers of applicants admitted to the individual degree programmes are stated in Annex 1.

The proposal for admission to study based on the results of the second round of the admission procedure is determined by the main admission committee. The final results of the admission procedure will be made available to applicants via the web portal <https://is.czu.cz/prihlaska/>.

4. After admission

4.1 Decision on admission

The proposal for admission to study is made by the main admission committee based on the fulfilment of all formal conditions and the result of the entrance examination. Applicants who are admitted to study will be asked to pay the tuition fee and to submit documents on the education attained:

Applicants who are graduates of a foreign higher education institution submit

- a document on completion of higher education in the Czech or English language that meets the conditions specified in Section 48(5) of the AHEI.

Applicants who are graduates of Czech higher education institution submit



- a document on completion of higher education in the Czech language that meets the conditions specified in Section 48(1) of the AHEI.

After verification of the above conditions (previous study in accordance with Section 48 of the AHEI) and after payment of the tuition fee (with the exception of applicants for the Smart Sustainable Solutions programme, whose study costs will be financed from the project according to point 4.2), the decision on admission will be sent to applicants via the web portal <https://is.czu.cz/prihlaska/>, or to the contact address stated in the application, or they will be invited to collect the decision on admission in person.

4.2 Tuition fee

The tuition fee in the current academic year is set by separate Regulation No. 10/2026. After enrolment in study, the tuition fee is non-refundable.

Tuition fees under this regulation apply to students who commence study in study programmes taught in English in the academic year 2027/2028 and will be valid for the standard duration of their studies.

The study costs of some of the students in the Smart Sustainable Solutions programme are co-financed by the project Knowledge Alliances 101140050 – ECOLUTION – ERASMUS-EDU-2023-PI-ALL-INNO. The selection of funded students is part of the admission procedure. In accordance with the objectives of the project and taking into account budgetary constraints, the proportion of funded students from third countries must not exceed 10% of the total number of students.

This restriction applies exclusively to eligibility for financial support and does not affect academic admission or participation in the programme. All applicants, regardless of nationality, will be assessed equally on the basis of academic criteria and the quality of the application.

4.3 Enrolment in study

Details on the enrolment procedure and the required documents will be sent to admitted applicants via the web portal <https://is.czu.cz/prihlaska/>. The dates of enrolment of admitted applicants in study and its conditions are regulated by Annex 2.

Annex 2

Instructions for enrolment in bachelor's and follow-up master's programmes taught in English in full-time form of study for the academic year 2027/2028

The Dean of the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU specifies the conditions for enrolment in study for newly commencing students in the first years of bachelor's and follow-up master's degree programmes taught in English for the academic year 2027/2028 at the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU.

Important dates

The dates stated apply to all bachelor's and full-time follow-up master's degree programmes taught in English at the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU.

In-person enrolment in study for each degree programme	21 September 2027
Payment of the tuition fee for study in English	by 31 August 2027
Submission of applications for internal evaluations of foreign education within the admission procedure	by 25 November 2027

Additional enrolment options

Applicants admitted to study in follow-up master's programmes taught in English who, in the current year, complete a bachelor's degree programme at the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU will be allowed to enroll in study also on the date 30 June – 1 July 2027.

Newly admitted applicants who plan to enroll in the academic year 2027/2028 in bachelor's and follow-up master's degree programmes taught in English are granted the option of enrolment after the standard enrolment date. An admitted applicant always enrolls through the Study Department of the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU in cooperation with the International Relations Office of the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU, without the possibility of splitting the year. An individual study plan is granted only in exceptional and justified cases.

Additional individual enrolment is possible in two periods:

1. from 22 September 2027 to 14 October 2027
2. from 24 January 2028 to 10 February 2028

In the period from 15 October 2027 to 23 January 2028, it is not possible to enroll in study.

Students enrolled during the 1st period of additional individual enrolment will have the opportunity to study in the winter and summer semesters of the academic year 2027/2028. These students will be subject to the obligations under the Study and Examination Regulations of CZU.



Students enrolled during the 2nd period of additional individual enrolment will have the opportunity to study only in the summer semester of the academic year 2027/2028.

For the following academic year, these students must apply to the Dean of the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU for a repetition of the year under the Study and Examination Regulations of CZU, so that they can duly complete the unfulfilled subjects of the 1st year of their degree programme.

Instructions for enrolment in the follow-up master's programme Smart Sustainable Solutions taught in English for the academic year 2027/2028

The Dean of the Faculty of Environmental Sciences CZU specifies the conditions for enrolment in study for newly commencing students in the first years of the master's degree programme Smart Sustainable Solutions for the academic year 2027/2028.

Important dates

Enrolment in study	by 31 October 2027
Payment of the tuition fee for study in English	by 31 August 2027

Before enrolment in study, applicants do not have access to teaching materials in the University Information System or to other CZU teaching channels. Unenrolled applicants also cannot draw scholarships intended for CZU students.
