

**Dean's regulation no. 04/2009,
determining the obligation of PhD students to prepare a literature review
in the 1st year of study**

Students in their first year of the PhD programme are obligated to prepare a literature review on the dissertation topic by the end of the first year. The deadline is extended until November 11th, 2009 for the students who began their studies on October 1st, 2008. Whether the students have fulfilled this requirement will be checked during the annual assessment by the Field of Study Board. This regulation does not apply to the students who had begun their studies before the year 2008.

The literature review should be written in the form of a manuscript in Czech or English language. The manuscript can but does not have to be published. A single copy should be submitted to the Science and Research Department, confirmed by the supervisor's signature. The manuscript should be at least 20 pages long (1800 characters) and cite approximately 50 sources, mainly from international scientific databases. An extended literature review can be used in the PhD thesis for the student's State Exam.

This regulation comes into force on June 24th, 2009.
