## DEAN'S REGULATION No 2/2020

---

# Ensuring Study Conditions with Regard to the Coronavirus Pandemic as of 25th May 2020

### **Article 1**

#### **Preamble**

- (1) In order to stop spreading the coronavirus infection and based on Rector's Decision No 15/2020 and in accordance with the Decision of the Government of the Czech Republic No 555 of 18 May 2020 concerning some extraordinary measures of the Ministry of Health this methodology regulation stipulates the rules and procedures of ensuring the study conditions at CZU.

### **Article 2**

#### **Conditions for Personal Presence at FES CZU**

- (1) Based on the Article 2 Paragraph 3 of Rector's Decision No 15/2020 the recommendation to use (if possible) distant teaching and testing methods for verification of students' knowledge is still valid. Contact (face-to-face) forms of tuition should be used only exceptionally, and they are allowed whilst meeting the following conditions.
- (2) The maximum number of students in a group supervised by a CZU teacher must not exceed 15 persons (this condition does not apply to field, practical and clinical sessions).
- (3) All persons participating in the contact form of study are to meet the following requirements:
  - a. they must not have acute health problems showing symptoms of viral infectious disease (e.g. fever, cough, shortness of breath, sudden loss of taste and smell, etc.),
  - b. they need to do thorough hand disinfection with disinfectants provided by the FES CZU,
  - c. they are not subjected to quarantine measures at that time,



- d. students need to sign a declaration of honour concerning non-existence of viral disease symptoms provided by a teacher stating that there have not shown any symptoms of a viral infectious disease in the last two weeks,
  - e. they need to comply with the requirements for the use of protective equipment covering the nose and mouth (e.g. with face masks, mouth caps, respirators, scarves, etc.). The only exception is the situation where the number of persons in a room does not exceed 15 persons (students and teachers) and the distance between persons is at least 1.5 meter. In such a case the students, participants of entry exams, academic staff members, state and entrance examination committee members are not obliged to use respiratory protective equipment.
- (4) The organizer of these activities (an examiner or a teacher from the academic staff) is responsible for compliance with the conditions mentioned above. The students are responsible for observing the conditions set in Paragraph 3 of this Article. The faculty is responsible for providing disinfectants.
- (5) It is necessary to keep the record of the presence of individual persons (students and employees). A teacher that organizes contact tuition or testing at FES CZU keeps the record of the time of the presence of their individual students.

### **Article 3 Final Provisions**

- (1) This Dean's Regulation is issued based on Rector's Decision No 15/2020 and Methodology Guidelines for Ensuring Study Conditions of 25 May 2020.
