

**Dean's Regulation no. 11/2020****The fee for study undertaken in a foreign language for the
academic year of 2021/2022 at the Faculty of Environmental
Sciences, CZU Prague**

Pursuant to Section 58(5) of Act No. 111/1998 Coll., on Higher Education Institutions, and in compliance with Internal Regulations in CZU Prague, the Dean of the Faculty of Environmental Sciences, CZU Prague, determines the amount of the tuition fees for programmes provided in foreign languages for the academic year 2021/2022.

Under Section 58(5) of the Act, tuition fees for programmes in foreign languages for the individual study programmes are as follows:

Tuition fees for study programmes undertaken in foreign languages apply to each commenced year of study and are payable before enrolment in study or before enrolment in the following years of study. The amount of the tuition fee is set and valid only for the current academic year 2021/2022.

The tuition fee may change in the next academic year, according to the Faculty of Environmental Sciences Dean's Regulation.

Fees are generally paid by bank transfer or in cash at the cash desk of CZU and are understood as paid on the day when credited to the bank account of CZU or when paid at the cash desk of CZU. Fees are non-refundable after enrollment.
