

DEAN'S INSTRUCTION no. 02/2021**Methodological instruction for enrollment to bachelor's and master's degree programmes taught in English for the academic year 2021/2022 at the Faculty of Environmental Sciences, CZU Prague**

The Dean of the Faculty of Environmental Sciences (FES), CZU Prague specifies conditions for prospective fresh first year students who are going to enrol for study in bachelor's and master's degree programmes taught in English in the academic year 2021/2022.

Article 1

Important deadlines

Article 2

Additional option of individual in-person enrollment to study

Newly admitted students who are going to enrol in the academic year 2021/2022 to bachelor's and master's degree programmes taught in English are granted with the option to enrol in a study later than during the standard enrolment day. These terms are divided into two phases and admitted student always enrol with the Study Administration Office FES in cooperation with the International Relations Office FES without the option for dividing up or changing the course of the prescribed study plans. An Individual study plan is granted for exceptional and reasonable cases.

Phase of in-person fresh first year student enrollment to study in 2021/2022	Date
1. phase	from September 21, 2021 until November 11, 2021
2. phase	from January 17, 2022 until February 3, 2022

From November 12, 2021 until January 16, 2022 (between both phases) it is not possible to enrol to study.

Students enrolled during the first enrollment phase will have the option to study for the winter and summer semester of academic year 2021/2022. These students will follow the Study and Exam Rules CZU's requirements and duties.

Students enrolled during the second phase will have the option to study only for the summer semester of the academic year 2021/2022. In the next academic year 2022/2023, these students will be recommended to submit a request to the Dean of FES to repeat the whole year and study courses not completed during the first year of study, according to the Study and Exam Rules CZU.

In the case of enrolled CZU students, online remote learning follows the rules of current governmental restrictions and the Rector's regulation. Unenrolled students will not have the option to use the university information system and other learning tools and systems before enrolment.

Unenrolled students will not have the option to use scholarships reserved for enrolled CZU students.
